Requirements:

- Registered nurse
- PhD in nursing or related fields. If the PhD is not in Nursing at least one of the previous academic degrees preferably is in Nursing
- Peer-reviewed publications
- Experience in applying research grant proposals to competitive funds, managing and conducting research
- Academic teaching experience
- Ability to teach in Hebrew will be given preference
- Priority for those who have Post-Doctoral training abroad.

Interested applicants are requested to send the following information until May 31st:

- CV including publication list and teaching experience
The format of the CV should follow the template in English on the Faculty's web site:

- Three selected publications which will be used for evaluation
- A cover letter that will describe research areas and plans as well as potential contribution to nursing.
- A scientific biography (2-3 pages)
- The names and full contact information of three academic faculty members who have expressed their willingness to write letters of recommendation
- Results of teaching evaluation (if available)
