Requirements:

- Holds an undergraduate and/or graduate degree in nursing
- Clinical and research experience in symptoms and/or palliative care will be an advantage
- Peer-reviewed publications
- Experience in submitting research grant proposals to competitive funds, managing and conducting research
- Experience in academic teaching in Hebrew
- Priority will be given to candidates with post-doctoral training abroad

- CV including list of publication and teaching experience

- Three selected publications which will be used for evaluation
- A cover letter that describes research areas, future research plans, and potential contribution to the nursing department.

- Teaching evaluations (if available)
