## **L. Summary of my Activities and Future plans**

I believe that parallel to the educational process in nursing, the key values that nursing is founded on – humanism, caring, and providing equal care to all people regardless of religion, gender, nationality, skin color, social or economic status – must be maintained and anchored. In order to help our students through the dynamic educational process, we must create learning stimuli and an environment that contributes to the students' independence and responsibility, and motivation to develop in this profession. I want to continue to initiate and promote academic and research cooperation with the community, to create international collaborations, and to develop the nursing department at Ruppin Academic Center.

My research interests are primarily women's health and pain, health promotion, nursing education. It has been argued that women have specific health needs aside from those of the community as a whole.
