- 6. Characterize different patient populations, their health needs, and special health services



#### Learning tasks:

- 1. Report on health services: Write a report (2-3 pages) on each service visited according to the following instructions:
  - · Name of the service
  - A brief description of the service objectives and its activities
  - Discussion of match between the needs of patients or population and the service provided
  - Describe the activities of each service designed to promote health and disease prevention and explain each briefly
  - Your impression of the service provided
  - · Write conclusions linking your personal impressions and cited literature syllabus bibliography list
- **2. Reflection**: Write a reflective journal of your learning experience. You can select guidelines on reflection from the examples on the website of the course. There are many guideline options and can you use more than one.
- 3. Final presentation (group):
  - Review your reports on the services that you visited and make some general conclusions.
  - Compare the services you saw in Israel to those you know in Norway.
  - Briefly present the comparisons that you made.
  - Briefly present your conclusions and personal impressions.

Observation: Instruction for guided observation

- I. Observation on professional activity
  - Choose a professional service worker (nurse, social worker, doctor, etc.) and get their approval to view the various activities they perform.
  - View at the performances and note:
  - 1. What kind of interactions they are involved with
  - 2. What kind of **decision making** they are dealing with
  - 3. How they are coping with conflicts
  - 4. How they are cooperating with their collages

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
### II. Observation on Health Care Environments

- How does these components affect:
- 1. Activities of professionals
- 2. Service delivery
- 3. Quality of Service
- 4. Professional interactions
- 5. Satisfaction of clients and service recipients

<u>Interviews of professionals</u>: Leading questions in an interview (These are examples of questions. You can choose the most relevant questions)

- What are the main objectives of the service / your professional activities?
- What does the service offer?
- What advantages does the service provide?
- What disadvantages can be found in the service?
- How do providers of the service check the satisfaction of service recipients?
- Bring an example of a success story of service.
- Which challenges do you face?
- What would you like to happen to the service in 5 years from now?
- What activities are included in the service and what activities does the service conduct to monitor and evaluate itself?
- What is success regarding service provision to you?
- What are the differences between addressing service goals and what you can provide as a nurse?
- What characterizes the population receiving the service?
- What do you think are the needs of the population, and how does the service address these needs?
- How does the service recognize the needs of the population?
- What aspects of the service do you like?







- What would you do differently in your service?
- How does the service consider the context of the community?
- What community partnerships are included in providing the service?
- What's being done in the service to get the cooperation of the population?
- How the service deals with the lack of cooperation of the population or individuals in it?
- What is the vision of the service?
- What is the mission of the service?
- What activities and strategies are designed to prevent disease? Which are designed to address health promotion?
- How does the service relate to the various cultures in the population?
